Worrying! Too many missed school days. Less chance of success.

96.9% - 93% UP TO 14 DAYS ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL
Concern! Reduced chance of success. Possible court action.

92.9% - 90% UP TO 20 DAYS ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL
Serious! Lowest chance of success. Possible court action.

Below 90% CONSIDERABLE ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL
