STRIKE ACTION - as you may have seen in the press, strike action is continuing with nurses, doctors, teachers, and many other professions for the foreseeable future.

Teachers from the NEU are on strike again next week (Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April) and this will mean that school will only be open to children in <u>Year 1</u> (Class 3 and 4), <u>Year 4</u> (Class 9 and 10), <u>Year 6</u> (Class 13 and 14) and identified vulnerable pupils. Children in these year groups must attend school as normal, it is not optional.
