**Routines**

This ½ term, we will be working on thread 1 of our positive behaviour for learning policy - ROUTINES. At Eastfield, we have 3 step routines for everything - every morning, we meet and greet your children on the gate / classroom doors, we then check in with them and see how they are feeling - are they green, blue, yellow or red? and we then get straight onto our tasks. We repeat this routine after playtime and dinnertime and regularly check in with the children throughout the day. Could you try this routine at home? Each week I will share with you behaviour tips and talk about thread 1 so that we can work together.
