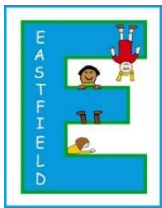
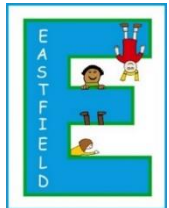




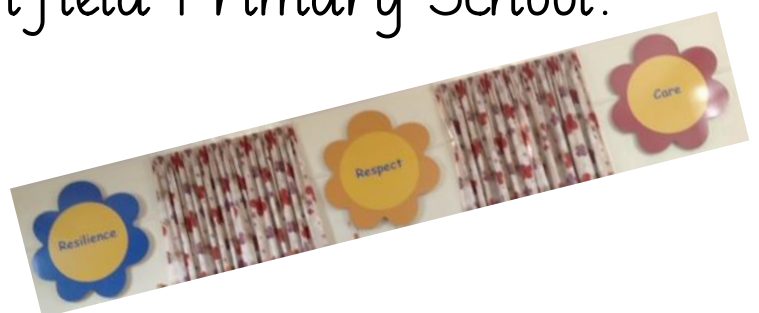
# Welcome to Eastfield Primary School
