




Please download The SIMs parent app, as it allows you to check your child's attendance and achievements. You will also receive notifications and communications via the SIMS parent app.



At Eastfield, we recognise that some children have additional needs that can't always be met within a mainstream classroom all of the time.

We want all children to succeed so it may be necessary for your child to access the Early Phase classroom to ensure their needs are met and they feel happy and safe in school.

If we feel your child would benefit from this provision, Mrs Fellow's will arrange a meeting with you in July to discuss the needs of your child. Your child's transition meeting will then be 10:30-11:15am on Thursday 6th July.
