Mrs Bird, Deputy Head Teacher.

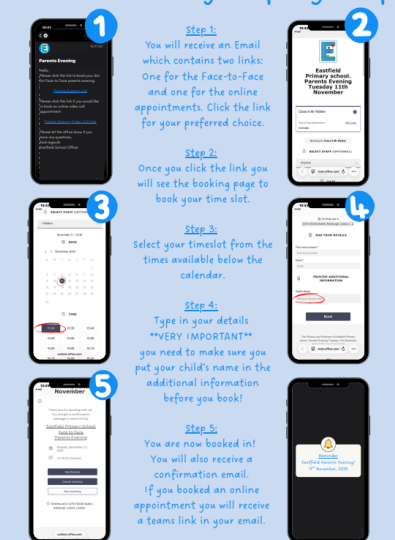
