WORD OF THE WEEK - This week our word is 'RADIANT'

It is an adjective. It means bright with joy and hope. It is based on Latin radiāns "shining," the present participle of the verb radiāre "to radiate light, shine," which is based on the noun radius "beam, ray."
Synonyms: shining, bright, beaming, gleaming, brilliant, glowing, glittering, illuminated, lit
E.g Someone who is radiant is so happy that their happiness shows in their face. Kathy smiled at her daughter's radiant face. On her wedding day the bride looked truly radiant.
Please ask your child about the word 'RADIANT' and encourage them to use this word in their everyday talking and their homework.
