Our Autumn learning...

Mathematics	We will start the term by learning to add three single digit numbers. We will continue to learn to add 2 digit numbers and ones, and tens, and another 2 digit number. This will link to statistics.
English	Our learning will be focused around the Julia Donaldson stories 'The Smartest Giant in Town' and 'Room on the Broom'. We will innovate stories, write instructions and write poetry.
Science	We will be learning about animals including humans and electricity.
History	We will be exploring different types of transport through the ages, focusing on canals and railways in Wolverhampton.
Geography	Investigating our local area.
PE	Small sided invasion games (hockey/netball). In Dance we will move at different levels and heights.
Art	Drawing shapes (Picasso) and Shapes (Owen Jones).
DT	Construction (building a canal tunnel) and food safety (muffins).
RE	Holy places—what is it like inside a Mosque, Church and Synagogue.
PSHE	We will be learning about 'diversity' and will investigate our community.
Music	Hands, Feet, Heart and Ho Ho Ho.
Computing	We will be using iPads for animation to create simple stop motion, also programming to create a conversation.
