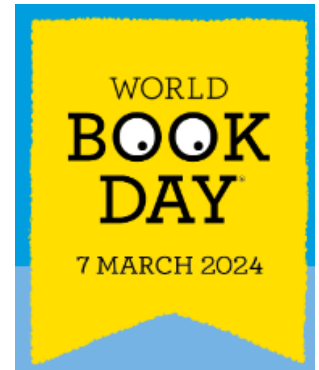

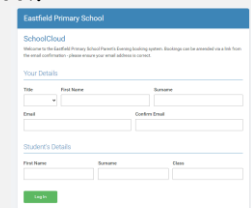


PARENT'S EVENING
