WORD OF THE WEEK - This week our word is 'EMBELLISH'

This week's word of the week is 'embellish.'
It is a verb. It means to decorate or make beautiful. It also has the meaning of making statements or stories sound more interesting or exciting through adding or changing details, using exaggeration, or telling slight untruths.
Synonyms: adorn, decorate, garnish, exaggerate, elaborate, enhance, beautify
E.g The book was embellished with pictures.
E.g The little girl always embellished the truth and so no-one believed her when something bad happened to her.

Please ask your child about the word 'EMBELLISH' and encourage them to use this word in their everyday talking and their homework.
