

How we support children at Eastfield



Thread 1 is a behavior support plan we follow at Eastfield to support children by setting expectations with a routine. We recommend following thread 1 at home to establish a consistent routine to support your children.

Meet and greet - Daily greeting - This will foster a sense of belonging, being recognised in a positive way. Meet and greet gives a sense of connectivity.

Example: Good morning ...

Zones of regulation check in- A light hearted process at the beginning of the day to develop social communication skills..

This builds community and starts the process of children thinking how they can change their behavior.

Example: What zone are you in and why?, Why do you feel this way?, What could we do to change this?

This is what we will be learning this term. Our theme is 'Tomb Raiders'.

Theme - History/Geography - The key theme of our topic is Ancient Egypt. We will be learning about what we can find out about Ancient Egypt from what has survived. In Geography, we will learn about the River Nile and its impact on people and environment.
