SCHOOL COMMS (Gateway)

Our new and improved system for online payments: SchoolComms



Parents we have listened! We have heard about the difficulties with Pay360 and so we are changing to a new system for payments. As we are a cashless school, we wanted to make payments as easy as possible for you all, so we will be using the **School Comms School Gateway App** for all future trips, dinner moneys, uniform, and any other payments.

The **School Comms (gateway) app** is a simple 4digit pin system that takes seconds to set up. All you need to do is to make sure we have your correct email address and phone number to get set up on the app.

When you download the app for the first time you will need to click 'sign up' at the bottom of the screen. There you will enter your email and phone number. It will send you a 4-digit temporary pin directly to your phone. Once you use that to log in for the first time you can change this to a more memorable pin. From there you should stay logged in.

But if you ever do forget your details, have no fear! No more having to wait 24 hours for your account to be reset, you can do this yourself by selecting "forgotten PIN?". A new temporary pin will be sent to your phone, and you will be able to log in from there.

We do suggest downloading the app and setting up an account, so you are ready for next term. Miss Cole and Mrs Stewart are very excited about it and know it'll make payments easier for
