### Reports and Parent's evening

Next week (Wednesday), you will receive your child's end of year report via email (children in Reception, Y1, Y2, Y4 and Y6 will also have statutory information sent home). There will then be an opportunity for you to discuss your child's report and results with the class teacher and for you to look at your child's books at our 'drop in' parent's evening on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July between 3:30-4:30pm. This parent's evening is a drop in, with no appointments needed. Teachers will be present in the classrooms until 4:30pm to answer any questions that you may have about your child's report. Children will be dismissed at the normal end of school time 3:20pm and parents will then be asked to re-enter via the main office at 3:30pm. At this meeting you will be given your child's latest Maths and Reading tests (PUMA / PIRA tests) so that you can see how well your child is performing.

#### Sports day

Next week (Friday), we will be having our sports day on the school field (weather permitting). The double gates by the Nursery / Community Centre (Gate D) will be opened at 10:30am for our Juniors / KS2 sports morning (Classes

7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14) and then opened again at 1:30pm for our infants / KS1 afternoon (Classes 1,2,3,4,5,6). Sports morning / afternoon start at 10:45am / 1:45pm and last approx. 1 hour. All children are in 2 races - sprint and another race (lap, obstacle, egg and spoon, sack etc. Children attend school in their PE uniform (wearing a T-shirt in their house colour). All children will be provided with water and a 'fruit shoot' during the event.
