Our theme this term is...

## Wonder Women!

**English** – Children will start the term by writing a set of instructions, and then they will create their very own leaflet about Florence Nightingale. After half term, they will explore the author Roger Hargreaves and create their very own Mr Men or Little Miss story. Finally, they learn how to write a non-chronological report.

**Maths** – Our focus for this term will be division, fractions and measurement, this includes money and clocks.



**Science** – Children learn about plants and investigate what bulbs and seeds need to grow into mature plants. We will also learn about everyday materials. They will sort and compare different materials, describe the properties as well as investigating the suitability of different materials,

**Art** – Both of our art topics will be taught in Summer 2. Children create a sculpture and learn about the artists Claes Oldenburg and Andy Goldsworthy. Children will also learn about Van Gough and contrasting colours.



**DT** – Children will learn how to sew by creating hand puppets. Children will also learn how to crack an egg and grate cheese, whilst making a quiche.

**Geography** – We will be comparing our local area with the Crimea, a contrasting locality outside Europe. We will also learn about physical and human features and learn to read maps of larger areas.

**History** – Children will learn about important women in history who were nurses, in particular Florence Nightingale, and hospital workers, by investigating their lives. They will be comparing their lives to nurses in the present day.



**PE** – Children will learn basic orienteering skills. Children will learn how to read a map and race to find different clues and places. Children will also be learning athletics skills.

**PSHE** – Children will learn about people who help us. They will also explore drugs and alcohol.

**RE** – We will be finding out about the 5 Pillars of Islam and different Muslim beliefs.

**Computing** – Children will explore different ways to create digital sound and they will learn how to record and edit a simple film clip.



**Music** – Children will learn that they can make different types of sounds with their voices.
