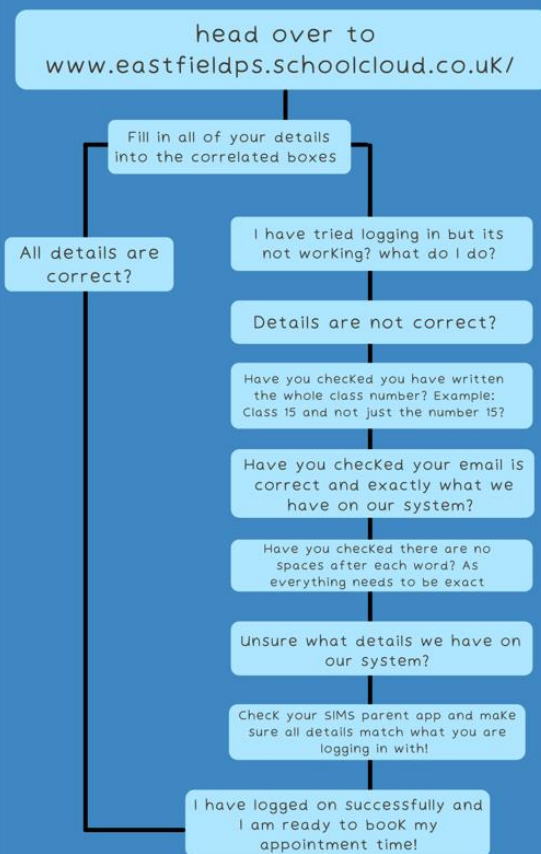
### PARENT'S EVENING - book your appointment.
