### Theme for the Autumn Term 2021

#### Mexican Hats



This Term we are learning about:

**English – Fiction:** Children's novels, film narrative, and poetry.

**Non-fiction:** Journalistic writing and arguments.

**Maths:** Place value of numbers to 10,000,000. Addition and subtraction.

**Science topic-:** Living things, Animals and Humans, Heart, organs, human circulatory and respiratory system.
