### **WORD OF THE WEEK - Last week** **our word was** **'VOCABULARY'**

It is a noun. Vocabulary means a list or collection of words. Vocabulary is all the words known and used by a particular person. It is all the words that exist in a particular language or subject.

**Synonyms:** language, words, slang, lingo, terminology, jargon  
E.g. Reading has helped to developed the child's vocabulary.

E.g. The child has learned a lot of new vocabulary in the French lessons.  
E.g. By the age of 2, a child will have a vocabulary of about 200 words.
