What is child protection and safeguarding all about?

- All the adults around you at Eastfield Primary think that your health, safety and welfare are very important
- In our school we respect our children and help to protect their rights
- We do our best to help all children make good educational progress
- We teach children how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect themselves and stay safe

How do we protect children at Eastfield Primary School?

- We make our school a safe place for children to learn in
- We help to ensure that children remain safe in school and at home
- We think it is important for our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something

If you need to talk, we will listen

- You can talk to any adult in school if you need to, they will **ALWAYS** be there for you – just **tell** them!
- Tell a friend and then go with your friend to tell an adult



Don't keep it secret if someone is:



Bullying you

Saying things to you that you do not like or things that upset you

Touching you

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol

Hitting you or hurting you

Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone



Sometimes the adults in school will need to speak to the Head Teacher and she may need to contact the police or a children's social worker to help keep you safe but you must not worry if this happens as they are all here to protect and support you!
